


Financial Aid Overview

Financial aid is assistance offered to you and your family to help meet the gap between what you can contribute to your education and what it costs to attend college. Financial aid can be in the form of federal grants, state grants, work study, scholarships, and loans.

Financial Aid Formula

For financial purposes, need is determined by the following formula:

Cost of Attendance - Student Aid Index - Other Financial Assistance = Need

Student Aid index (SAI)

This is the measure used to determine a student and family's ability to pay for college and the amount of financial aid they can receive.

Cost of Attendance

The total cost of attendance will vary if you choose to live at home with family, on campus, or off campus. Below is the estimated cost of attendance for students living on campus for the academic year Fall 2026 – Spring 2027.

How to Apply

- 1. Complete the FAFSA or CA Dream Act Application. Both will be available in October.
 - The priority filing deadline date is March 2, annually. For a new admit student to be considered for the Educational Opportunity Program (EOP), the FAFSA or CA Dream Act Application must be submitted by January 31
 - SJSU's Federal School Code: 001155
 - Free Application for Federal Student Aid (FAFSA) Submit the Free Application for Federal Student Aid, or FAFSA, at studentaid.gov
 - CA Dream Act Application Eligible AB 540 students (undocumented immigrant status) may qualify for state aid programs. Complete the California Dream Act Application at dream.csac.ca.gov
- 2. Your FAFSA or CA Dream Act Submission Summary will be sent electronically to your MySJSU email address after processing. This summary provides basic information about your eligibility for federal student aid and lists your answers to the questions on your FAFSA or CA Dream Act application.
- 3. Receive your actual award. Award amount(s) will be posted to MySJSU.
